Bucyrus Civic Grant 2025 Awards

The City received 12 Letters of Interest from local nonprofit organizations totaling \$121,930 in proposed projects.

The annual grant budget is \$50,000 with six nonprofits receiving funding.

\$8,000 Build storage shed and port with rainwater collection and solar for community gardens at 1308 Milwaukee.

MARM Farm

Convert 40-foot shipping container into SCUGU- self-contained urban growing unit for sustainable hydroponic farming, also used for education. Half of produce will be donated to Human Concerns

\$4,000 Purchase/delivery of shipping container

\$18,500 Purchase hydroponic units, solar panels, rainwater system
