

# **SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

## **WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 04/30/18 – 05/06/18**



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **291** calls for service.

### **ARMED ROBBERY**

Officers responded to a report of an armed robbery at a business in the 1100 Block of Marquette Avenue around 1:30 pm on May 6<sup>th</sup>. The business owner reported a male subject entered the business and upon displaying a hand gun, demanded money from him. The suspect described as a white male, in his 20's, 5' 11" to 6' tall, with curly blonde hair and wearing a tan or white hoodie, fled the area prior to officers arrival. Officers are continuing to investigate this incident.

### **DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

A 31 year old South Milwaukee man was issued citations for Disorderly Conduct and Resisting/Obstructing after officers responded to a report of subjects arguing in the 1800 Block of Minnesota Avenue shortly after 3:00 am on May 3<sup>rd</sup>. The South Milwaukee man was initially involved in an argument with a resident and left the area, but later returned to continue the argument and police were called. When officers advised him to leave the area, he refused and was subsequently arrested.

A 53 year old man was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct around 6:00 pm on May 6<sup>th</sup> in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue after he was kicked off a Milwaukee County Transit bus for causing a disturbance and shouting profanities at the bus driver.

## **RETAIL THEFT**

A 66 year old South Milwaukee man was arrested for Retail Theft and an outstanding South Milwaukee Police Department warrant around 10:30 am on May 5<sup>th</sup> in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue after leaving Walmart without paying for merchandise.

A 31 year old Milwaukee man was arrested for Retail Theft, Resisting/Obstructing, and a valid warrant with the Wisconsin Department of Corrections after attempting to leave Pick N Save without paying for merchandise in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue around 3:40 pm on May 5<sup>th</sup>. The man, who was on probation for felony retail theft, initially gave officers a false name and was taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility.

## **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

A 43 year old Milwaukee man was issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated following a vehicle stop in the 1800 Block of College Avenue shortly after 8:30 pm on May 5th.

A 29 year old South Milwaukee man was issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated, Open Intoxicants in a Motor Vehicle, and Operating After Suspension following a vehicle stop at Rawson and Nicholson Avenues at 5:50 pm on April 30<sup>th</sup>. Officers stopped the vehicle after witnesses reported the driver swerving in traffic.

## **VEHICLE THEFT**

A 2001 Dodge Neon was reported stolen from the 600 block of Menomonee Avenue sometime between 8:00 PM on May 4<sup>th</sup> and 11:00 AM on May 5<sup>th</sup>. Also, at 4:00 am on May 5<sup>th</sup>, three additional vehicles in the general vicinity were found to have damage. At this time it is unknown if these incidents are related but an investigation is continuing.
