

# ***SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT***

## ***WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 05/14/18 – 05/20/18***



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **276** calls for service.

### **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

A 38 year old Milwaukee man was issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated and was charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with Felony Fleeing from an Officer after a short 1.2 mile pursuit just after 2:00 am May 19<sup>th</sup> on North Chicago Avenue. An officer noticed a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed at North Chicago and Rawson Avenues and attempted to pull it over when the driver sped up and fled. The vehicle stopped briefly in traffic at North Chicago and College Avenues then continued to flee as officers approached. The vehicle was eventually stopped with the assistance of officers from the city of Cudahy and the driver who had no identification on him was taken into custody. He was taken to the South Milwaukee Police Department where identification was made and was then transported to the Milwaukee County Jail.

### **THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE**

A resident in the 800 Block of Menomonee Avenue reported his vehicle was entered and items were taken sometime during the overnight hours from May 15<sup>th</sup> to May 16<sup>th</sup>.

## **TRESPASS**

20 individuals from the cities of Oak Creek, Racine, Cudahy, and Franklin were issued citations for trespassing after officers were dispatched to a large group creating a disturbance in the 3500 Block of Blakewood Avenue shortly after 10:00 pm on May 14<sup>th</sup>. The group came to the area after earlier being advised by the Oak Creek Police Department to leave Bender Park in the city of Oak Creek.

## **MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT**

A three vehicle motor vehicle accident was reported at Nicholson and Minnesota Avenues at 4:15 pm on May 19<sup>th</sup>. The driver of a southbound pick-up truck reported his brakes failed as his vehicle struck an on-duty southbound Oak Creek Police squad before also striking a northbound sedan. The driver of the pick-up truck, a 31 year old South Milwaukee man was issued a citation for Operating After Revocation.

## **RETAIL THEFT**

A 30 year old Milwaukee woman was issued a citation for Obstructing an Officer after a report of a female concealing items in a backpack at Wal Mart in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue just after 2:00 am on May 19<sup>th</sup>. When confronted the woman stated she intended to pay for the items and the store did not wish to pursue retail theft charges. After giving officers multiple false names, her true identity was learned which revealed an active valid warrant with Community Corrections.

A 55 year old Milwaukee man was issued a citation for Retail Theft in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue after leaving Pic N Save without paying for a bottle of liquor shortly after 7:00 pm on May 18<sup>th</sup>.
