

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 05/29/18 – 06/03/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **242** calls for service.

BATTERY

A 47 year old South Milwaukee woman reported being punched in the face by a woman in the 3300 Block of Marina Road at 8:35 pm on May 29th. The case is currently pending the identification of the suspect who is reportedly 40-49 years of age, homeless, and known to the victim only on a first name basis.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

Officers were dispatched to a report of an argument between a 29 year old West Allis man and a 43 year old South Milwaukee man in the 1200 Block of Marquette Avenue around 2:30 pm on May 31st. The argument was the result of a reported vehicle accident in the 2400 Block of 13th Avenue in which the South Milwaukee man claimed the West Allis man struck his car door while the vehicle was parked with the door open. Officers observed minor damage to both vehicles but could not determine the West Allis man intentionally struck the vehicle. The West Allis man was issued a citation for Operating Without Insurance.

RETAIL THEFT

A 61 year old Milwaukee man was issued citations for Retail Theft and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia at 7:30 am on May 29th after attempting to leave Pick N Save in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue without paying for liquor and soap. The man was also found to be in possession of a marijuana pipe.

Officers were dispatched to Wal Mart in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue at 10:00 am on May 29th after two males left the store without paying for two DVD players and an auto back-up and dash camera system. When confronted by Security Personnel, the two males fled the scene in a gold colored Toyota prior to officer's arrival.

A 23 year old Oak Creek man was issued a citation for Retail Theft after he was observed by Security Personnel opening a bag of licorice and eating it inside Pick N Save in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue at 9:50 pm on May 29th. The man, who paid for other items and admitted to eating the candy with no intention of paying for it, was issued a citation and released.

A 30 year old Milwaukee man and a 59 year old West Allis woman were issued citations for Retail Theft and Trespassing after they were observed by Security Personnel leaving Wal Mart in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue without paying for diabetic test strips at 9:50 am on May 31st. Both the man and the woman had been previously arrested for Retail Theft at Wal Mart and were banned from the store at that time.
