

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 05/07/18 – 05/13/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **289** calls for service.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

A window was reported broken at the Wulff Lodge in the 200 Block of Lake Drive around 1:30 pm on May 8th.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

A 69 year old South Milwaukee man was issued citations for Unlawful Burning and Disorderly Conduct at 10:30 am on May 8th in the 1700 Block of Cedar Street. South Milwaukee Fire Department personnel reported the man has been warned on the burning violations numerous times in the past and he began yelling and threatening people in the area.

A 20 year old South Milwaukee man was mailed citations for Unnecessary Noise at 9:40 pm on May 8th and 11:15 pm on May 10th in the 2000 Block of 10th Avenue after officers were dispatched to a complaint of loud music.
