

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 06/18/18 – 06/24/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **249** calls for service.

ANIMAL COMPLAINT

A 75-year old South Milwaukee man was arrested after a 22 year old woman and a 53 year old woman, both from South Milwaukee, reported being bitten by a vicious dog. Officers responded to the 1000 Block of Milwaukee Avenue around 8:30 pm on June 23rd after two dogs were let out of an apartment by the landlord. One of the dogs bit both women and they were taken to the hospital for their injuries. Officers were able to capture the dog that bit the women however the other dog ran from the area. Both dogs were eventually located and the dog that bit the women was turned over to the Milwaukee Area Domestic Animal Control Center. The 75 year old man (landlord) who allowed the animals to roam the neighborhood has been referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for charges. The vicious dog is under quarantine at MADACC.

THEFT

Over 20 truck batteries were reported stolen from a business in the 1000 Block of Columbia Avenue sometime between 8:00 pm on June 18th and 6:30 am on June 19th. An alert citizen assisted officers in identifying a 33 year old South Milwaukee man and a 27 year old South Milwaukee man as suspects and both were arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for charges.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Three umbrella stands and a planter box at the Azteca restaurant in the 900 Block of Milwaukee Avenue were damaged by two unknown subjects around 1:40 am on June 20th. Surveillance video showed two males approach the restaurant on foot and break the umbrella stands and push over the planter box. One of the males was wearing a shirt with #9 on it. Police are working to identify the two male suspects and anyone with further information should contact the South Milwaukee Police Department at (414) 768-8060.

WARRANT ARREST

A 57 year old South Milwaukee man was arrested on a valid warrant with the West Allis Police Department just after 2:00 am in the 1300 Block of Nicholson Avenue on June 23rd after officers were dispatched to report of a suspicious person coming onto a property uninvited and making bizarre statements. The man, who had been drinking, told officers he observed the property owners outside by a fire and decided to join them. The man was booked on the West Allis PD warrant and released on a personal recognizance bond.

THEFT

A 20 year old Cudahy man was issued a citation for Theft after he was located by the Cudahy Police Department operating a WalMart handicap motor scooter in their city just after 8:30 pm on June 22nd. The man admitted the motor scooter was taken from WalMart in South Milwaukee and he was turned over to South Milwaukee police officers who issued him the theft citation. The motor scooter was returned to WalMart.

THREAT

A 44 year old Cudahy man was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Disorderly Conduct While Armed, Criminal Damage to Property, and Resisting Arrest at 4:50 pm on June 24th after threatening his ex-girlfriend with a knife. The man who was taken into custody with the assistance of the Cudahy Police Department resisted officers and damaged the side quarter panel of a squad.
