

# **SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

## **WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 06/25/18 – 07/01/18**

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **249** calls for service.

### **STOLEN VEHICLE RECOVERY**

A 33 year old Cudahy man was arrested on a valid warrant with the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department at 6:40 am in the 3300 Block of Marina Road on June 26<sup>th</sup> after a vehicle reported stolen from Washburn County was located in the area. The 33 year old man, who was a suspect in the Washburn County case, was located in a nearby apartment. He was taken to the Waukesha County Jail on the warrant and referred to Washburn County authorities. The vehicle was towed to the South Milwaukee Police Department where arrangements were made for the owner to retrieve it.

### **THEFT**

A rear license plate was reported stolen from a vehicle parked in the 1000 Block of Sycamore Avenue sometime between Midnight on June 28<sup>th</sup> and 2:30 pm on June 29<sup>th</sup>.

A bicycle was reported stolen from outside Walgreen's in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue at 7:20 pm on June 27<sup>th</sup>. Witnesses and security video revealed the bicycle was taken by a younger looking male wearing a dark hoodie. ## **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

Officers were dispatched to a report of a subject in a vehicle dumping garbage into other resident's garbage bins when they located the man standing next to his vehicle urinating in the alley.

## **RETAIL THEFT**

A 42 year old South Milwaukee woman and a 44 year old Milwaukee woman were issued citations for Retail Theft at Pick N Save in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue at 5:45 pm on June 30<sup>th</sup> after attempting to leave the store without paying for packages of beef and shrimp. Officers viewed store video and observed the women intentionally fail to scan the items in the self-checkout line.

A 23 year old Milwaukee woman was issued a citation for Retail Theft at Pick N Save in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue just after 5:00 pm on June 29<sup>th</sup>. Store security observed the woman conceal hamburgers and ketchup in her purse and leave the store without paying for them. When stopped by officers, the woman removed the items from her purse and was issued the citation.
