

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 07/16/18 – 07/22/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **309** calls for service.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

Officers located a 29 year old South Milwaukee man with facial injuries after being dispatched to a report of a fight in progress in the 3100 Block of South Chicago at 5:55 pm on July 19th. The man stated he was arguing with a 26 year old South Milwaukee man who struck him and left the scene prior to officers arrival. The 29 year old man declined medical attention and the 26 year old man will be issued citations for Disorderly Conduct and Battery.

A 35 year old South Milwaukee woman reported she was struck by a vehicle while walking in the 1200 Block of Forest Hill Avenue at 11:10 pm on July 21st. Officers searched the area and were unable to locate the vehicle while the woman was taken to the hospital by South Milwaukee Fire Department personnel. An investigation later revealed the report was false and the woman will be issued a citation.

An 18 year old South Milwaukee man reported graffiti written on his vehicle with pink marker in the 2400 Block of 6th Avenue at 3:50 pm on July 17th. Following an investigation, a 17 year old Greenfield girl admitted to the graffiti and she was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct.

THEFT

A 44 year old South Milwaukee man reported numerous items and a bank card were taken from a residence in the 500 Block of Columbia Avenue around 6:15 pm on July 21st. Officers are attempting to locate a known suspect and an investigation is continuing.

A license plate was reported stolen from a vehicle in the 700 Block of Minnesota Avenue at 7:40 pm on July 21st.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

A 44 year old Oak Creek man was issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated and Speeding at 3:22 am near Nicholson and Rawson Avenues on July 19th after an officer observed a motorcycle traveling at 53 mph in a 35 mph posted zone.

A 42 year old Milwaukee man was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Operating While Intoxicated-2nd Offense after an officer observed his vehicle cross the center line and enter the oncoming lane of traffic in the 300 Block of Marion Avenue at 3:23 am on July 21st.

TRAFFIC OFFENSE

Officers observed a vehicle go through a red light at the intersection of 13th and Milwaukee Avenues and initiated a traffic stop in the 1700 Block of 13th Avenue at 6:54 pm on July 17th. As officers approached the vehicle it accelerated and fled the area. A short time later the vehicle was located in an alley in the 1200 Block of Manitoba Avenue with the driver's door open and no one in the driver's seat. Officers observed a younger male subject running through yards but were unable to apprehend him. The vehicle was towed to the South Milwaukee Police Department and an investigation is continuing as officers attempt to locate the vehicle owner and identify the driver after which citations will be issued.
