

# **SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

## **WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 07/23/18 – 07/29/18**



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **344** calls for service.

### **DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

A 28 year old Milwaukee man was issued citations for Disorderly Conduct and Resisting/Obstructing in the 1600 Block of Manitoba Avenue at 9:49 pm on July 28<sup>th</sup> after several Heritage Days festival patrons alerted officers to a highly intoxicated subject. After being advised to leave the festival due to his level of intoxication, the man refused and was subsequently arrested.

A 55 year old Milwaukee woman was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct in the 1100 Block of Milwaukee Avenue at 1:24 am on July 28<sup>th</sup>. Upon being dispatched to a 911 hang up call, officers located the highly intoxicated woman walking in the area. An officer safety search prior to giving her a ride to a bus stop revealed two steak knives in her purse and when she refused to let go of one of the knives she was arrested.

A 52 year old Milwaukee man was issued citations for Disorderly Conduct, Resisting/Obstructing and Lewd and Lascivious behavior at 8:44 pm on July 28<sup>th</sup> after officers were dispatched to a report of a male subject huffing aerosol cans and urinating in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue.

**A 28 year old South Milwaukee man was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Disorderly Conduct and Resisting/Obstructing after officers were dispatched to an unwanted subject at a residence in the 600 Block of Montana Avenue at 11:53 pm on July 25<sup>th</sup>. The man initially refused to leave the residence and later once outside began to yell loudly, creating a disturbance. The man was taken to the Police Department where he continued to be uncooperative until he was transported to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility.**

### **RETAIL THEFT**

**A 21 year old Milwaukee man was issued citations for Retail Theft after he left Pick N Save without paying for a bottle of whiskey and boarded a Milwaukee County Transit Bus at 8:48 am on July 23<sup>rd</sup> in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue. Store security personnel observed the man leave without paying for a bottle of whiskey and he turned over the bottle to them. Several minutes later, store security once again observed the man try to leave the store without paying for a bottle of whiskey and the police were called. The man was arrested and taken to the Police Department where he was issued citations.**

### **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

**A 61 year old Oak Creek woman was issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated following a traffic stop just after Midnight on July 28<sup>th</sup> near 15<sup>th</sup> and College Avenues.**

**A 49 year old Cudahy woman was issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated after the van she was driving struck a parked vehicle in the 1600 Block of Maple Street at 10:25 pm on July 28<sup>th</sup>.**
