

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 07/30/18 – 08/05/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **247** calls for service.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

A 28 year old Milwaukee woman was issued citations for Disorderly Conduct and Obstructing after officers were dispatched to a report of a person refusing to leave and threatening employees at CSL Plasma in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue at 12:55 pm on August 4th. Upon officers arrival, the woman refused to identify herself and continued to yell loudly and use profanity despite being advised not to. Once identified, it was learned the woman held two valid warrants with the city of Brown Deer police department. She was arrested and taken to the police station where citations were issued prior to being turned over to Brown Deer Police Department officers on the warrants.

A 13 year old Milwaukee girl was issued a citation for Obstructing and warned and advised on Disorderly Conduct after officers were dispatched to a report of a person attempting to start a fight with a group of people in the 1200 Block of Blake Avenue just before 5:00 pm on July 31st. The girl, who initially refused to identify herself, was arrested and taken to the police station where she was identified and issued the Obstructing citation before being released to her father.

A 57 year old South Milwaukee man was issued citations for Disorderly Conduct, Battery, and Resisting an Officer, and a 35 year old South Milwaukee woman was issued citations for Disorderly Conduct and Criminal Damage to Property, following reports of subjects arguing and windows being broken in the 1400 Block of Menomonee Avenue at 4:39 pm on August 4th.

SUSPICIOUS PERSON

A 26 year old South Milwaukee man was arrested on a valid warrant with the West Allis Police Department and was issued citations for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia after a resident in the 1700 Block of Rawson Avenue reported an unknown person sleeping in his vehicle just before 6:00 am on August 2nd. The man was taken to the police station where he was issued the citations and processed on the West Allis warrant before being released to his mother.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE TO PROPERTY

Three 18 year old women from Racine, Oak Creek, and Greenfield were issued citations for Criminal Damage to Property and Disorderly Conduct and a 17 year old Oak Creek girl was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct following a report of subjects damaging a parked vehicle in the 500 Block of Southtowne Place just after 1:00 am on July 31st. The women left the scene prior to officer arrival but later admitted their involvement after officers stopped the vehicle they were riding in as it matched the vehicle description provided by a witness.

Unknown individuals used rocks to break windows on buildings in the 1100 Block of Milwaukee Avenue and the 2200 Block of 12th Avenue during the overnight hours of July 30th to July 31st.
