

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 07/09/18 – 07/15/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **290** calls for service.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

Two 28 year old South Milwaukee men, a 28 year old Oak Creek man, and a 35 year old South Milwaukee man were all issued citations for Disorderly Conduct after officers responded to a report of a fight in the 1700 Block of Pine Street around 3:45 am on July 15th.

A 38 year old South Milwaukee woman was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct in the 1200 Block of Milwaukee Avenue just before 10:45 pm on July 12th after threatening a neighbor with physical assault.

A 53 year old South Milwaukee man was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct just before 7:50 am on July 12th after a 50 year old South Milwaukee man reported being threatened in the 300 Block of Southtowne Drive following a traffic dispute.

THEFT

A 37 year old West Allis man reported his wallet was taken while he was on a Milwaukee County Transit bus in the area of 10th and Monroe Avenues at 12:30 pm on July 12th. The man noticed the wallet missing upon exiting the bus and later discovered his bus card had been used since then. An investigation is ongoing.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

A 32 year old Oak Creek man was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for charges of Operating While Intoxicated 2nd Offense after being arrested in the 7200 Block of S. Pennsylvania Avenue in the city of Oak Creek at 10:16 pm on July 13th. An officer observed a vehicle veer over the center line in the 1600 Block of Rawson Avenue and the man was arrested.

A 35 year old South Milwaukee woman was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for charges of Operating While Intoxicated 2nd Offense and Operating After Revocation following a traffic stop in the 900 Block of Monroe Avenue at 12:24 am on July 15th. The woman was issued citations and turned over to the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department on a valid body only warrant.

RETAIL THEFT

A 68 year old South Milwaukee woman and a 43 year old South Milwaukee man were issued citations for Retail Theft after being observed by security personnel leaving WalMart in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue without paying for items at 5:40 pm on July 14th.

Two unknown males and a female left Pick N Save in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue without paying for packages of Red Bull at 1:22 pm on July 11th before leaving the area in a black Jeep. Officers are working to identify the subjects and an investigation is ongoing.
