

# **SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

## **WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 08/06/18 – 08/12/18**



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **374** calls for service.

### **VEHICLE THEFT**

A 54 year old South Milwaukee woman reported her 2004 Buick LeSabre was taken by a 32 year old Oak Creek man from the 100 Block of North Chicago Avenue at 7:00 am on August 4<sup>th</sup>. A warrant was issued for the Oak Creek man and he was taken into custody in the city of Milwaukee by officers from the Milwaukee Police Department on August 7<sup>th</sup>. The vehicle was recovered in the city of Milwaukee on August 13<sup>th</sup> and the man was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for charges.

### **WARRANT ARREST**

A 32 year old Milwaukee man wanted on a Felony Burglary warrant with the Milwaukee Police Department and a Probation Violation with the Wisconsin Department of Corrections was observed by officers riding a bicycle in the 100 Block of North Chicago at 1:50 pm on August 11<sup>th</sup>. The man attempted to elude officers and was eventually apprehended after a brief struggle. The man was issued a citation for Resisting Arrest and was turned over to officers from the Milwaukee Police Department.

## **DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

Officers were dispatched to the 1700 Block of Oak Street around Midnight on August 11<sup>th</sup> for a report of a 22 year old South Milwaukee man refusing to leave a residence after yelling and threatening his girlfriend. The man left the residence prior to the arrival of officers and was later located walking near Rawson and Nicholson Avenues where he was arrested. The man was taken to the Milwaukee County Jail and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a domestic violence related Disorderly Conduct charge.

A 57 year old South Milwaukee woman was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct after officers were dispatched to a report of damage to mailboxes in the 1800 Block of Milwaukee Avenue at 7:35 pm on August 6<sup>th</sup>. Multiple witnesses stated they observed the woman damage the metallic mailboxes by attempting to pull them off the wall and officers observed a long metal screw pulled out from the drywall.

## **RETAIL THEFT**

A 61 year old Milwaukee man was issued citations for Retail Theft and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia after leaving Walgreen's in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue without paying for personal care items and liquor just after 8:30 am on August 10<sup>th</sup>. Officers located the man in a nearby parking lot and the items taken were returned to the store. The man was also in possession of a crack pipe and he was arrested and taken to the police station where he was issued the citations and released.
