

# **SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

## **WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 08/20/18 – 08/26/18**



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **276** calls for service.

### **DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

A 28 year old Milwaukee man was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Disorderly Conduct While Armed after officers were dispatched to a report of an individual with a knife at McDonald's in the 2700 Block of South Chicago Avenue at 9:22 am on August 23<sup>rd</sup>. Several witnesses stated the man, who was asking patrons for money, became aggressive when told by a McDonald's employee to leave the area. Officers located the man at a nearby bus stop and upon searching him, found a knife in his back pants pocket. The man was subsequently arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Jail.

A 29 year old Oak Creek man, a 44 year old Oak Creek man, a 29 year old Milwaukee man, a 33 year old Oak Creek man, and a 57 year old South Milwaukee man were all issued citations for Disorderly Conduct after officers were dispatched to a group of people fighting in the 1800 Block of 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue just after 12:30 am on August 26<sup>th</sup>. The altercation began as the men were leaving a nearby tavern. The Milwaukee man and South Milwaukee man were also issued citations for Obstructing/Resisting after they became uncooperative with officers.

## **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

Officers were dispatched to a report of a hit and run accident at 15<sup>th</sup> and Manitowoc Avenues at 8:30 pm on August 25<sup>th</sup>. Upon officers arrival, a second call was received reporting a truck with significant front end damage driving in the 1100 Block of Marion Avenue. Officers located a 23 year old Cudahy man on foot in the area holding the keys to the truck. Several witnesses identified him as the driver of the vehicle. The man, who was intoxicated, became uncooperative with officers and was arrested. He was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Operating While Intoxicated-2<sup>nd</sup> Offense, Prohibited Alcohol Concentration-2<sup>nd</sup> Offense, Operating After Revocation, and Failure to Install an Ignition Interlock Device. He was also issued citations for Hit and Run Unattended, Unreasonable and Imprudent Speed, and Obstructing/Resisting.

A 52-year old Shorewood Woman was issued a citation for Operating While Intoxicated-First Offense following a traffic stop at 13<sup>th</sup> and Manitowoc Avenues at 8:40 pm on August 24<sup>th</sup>. A concerned citizen reported the woman's vehicle driving recklessly in the area. She was taken to the police station and issued a citation before being released to a family member.

## **SUSPICIOUS PERSON**

Officers received a report of a male subject knocking on doors and looking in mailboxes in the 3800 Block of Russett Lane at 2:38 pm on August 23<sup>rd</sup>. Officers noticed a vehicle leaving the area being driven by a man matching the description given by callers. The driver, a 27 year old Oak Creek man, admitted to being in the area and stated he was looking for his lost cell phone. He was arrested and issued citations after drug paraphernalia was located in his vehicle.
