

# **SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 08/27/18 – 09/03/18**



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **317** calls for service.

## **WEAPONS VIOLATION**

Shortly after 1:00 pm on September 2<sup>nd</sup>, Officers were notified by the Cudahy Police Department of a complaint received by a 52 year old Milwaukee man who reported several subjects in a vehicle displayed a gun to him as he rode his bicycle in Grant Park near Seven Bridges. Officers located the vehicle parked near 8<sup>th</sup> and Madison Avenues and observed individuals enter the vehicle after exiting a residence in the 700 Block of Madison Avenue. Officers also observed one of the individuals place a gun in the rear cargo area of the vehicle and a high risk felony stop was conducted. During the stop, other individuals exited the residence and became argumentative with officers. Two BB guns were located in the vehicle and the individuals were arrested without incident. A 20 year old South Milwaukee woman and a 14 year old Racine boy were issued citations for Disorderly Conduct while an 18 year old South Milwaukee man, a 14 year old South Milwaukee boy, and a 14 year old Milwaukee boy were all issued citations for Resisting/Obstructing.

## **DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

A 20 year old Milwaukee man was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct shortly after 9:00 am on August 31<sup>st</sup> after officers were dispatched to a report of an argument between a landlord and tenant in the 900 Block of Manitoba Avenue. The Milwaukee man was reportedly locked out of the residence after earlier entering the landlord's apartment and calling the landlord derogatory names. He was arrested and issued a citation after he continued to yell at the landlord while officers were present.

## **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

A 46 year old Greenfield man and a 46 year old South Milwaukee man came to the police station around 2:00 pm on September 3<sup>rd</sup> to report they were involved in a minor vehicle accident at 17<sup>th</sup> and Rawson Avenues. Further investigation revealed the South Milwaukee man to be intoxicated. He was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility on a charge of Operating While Intoxicated-8<sup>th</sup> Offense. He was also found to be in possession of Oxycodone pills and other drug paraphernalia.

A 39 year old South Milwaukee man was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Operating While Intoxicated-3<sup>rd</sup> Offense following a traffic stop in the 2100 Block of 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue at 12:50 am on September 1<sup>st</sup>.

## **RECKLESSLY ENDANGERING SAFETY**

Officers received a report of a male subject passed out in a vehicle in the parking lot of the Speedway gas station in the 2300 Block of 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue at 7:38 am on September 3<sup>rd</sup>. Upon the arrival of officers and fire department personnel, the vehicle fled the area at a high rate of speed. A brief pursuit was terminated for safety reasons. At 8:47 am the same vehicle was reported parked in the 700 Block of Aspen Street with a male subject passed out inside. Officers responded and arrested the vehicle owner, a 30 year old South Milwaukee man. He was taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Recklessly Endangering Safety, Fleeing an Officer, and Felony Bail Jumping. A 65 year old South Milwaukee man also received a citation for Obstructing an officer after he attempted to prevent the vehicle from being towed for evidence.
