

# **SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

## **WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 09/04/18 – 09/09/18**



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **235** calls for service.

### **FIRE**

Officers and South Milwaukee Fire Department personnel were dispatched to a report of a fire in the 400 Block of Southtowne Drive at 10:47 pm on September 8<sup>th</sup>. Upon arrival smoke was observed coming from an apartment in the DD Building of the Southtowne Village Apartments. All occupants were able to exit the building and the fire, which was concentrated in an apartment kitchen area, was extinguished by South Milwaukee Fire Department personnel. The incident remains under investigation by both the South Milwaukee Police Department and the South Milwaukee Fire Department.

### **TRESPASS**

A 17 year old South Milwaukee girl was issued a citation for Trespassing at Pick and Save in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue at 5:44 pm on September 4<sup>th</sup>. Earlier in the summer the girl had been advised she was not to return to the store after threatening security personnel. Officers were informed the girl had returned to the store and she was arrested and taken to the police station where she was issued the citation and released.

## **DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

A 21 year old South Milwaukee man was issued citations for Disorderly Conduct and Possession of Marijuana after officers were dispatched to a report of subjects arguing in the 900 Block of Madison Avenue around 2:00 am on September 4<sup>th</sup>. Witnesses stated the man entered a nearby tavern and when told the tavern was closed, began to argue with a 26 year old South Milwaukee man leaving the tavern. The 21 year old man was arrested and taken to the police department where he was issued the citations before being taken to his residence.

## **WARRANT ARREST**

A 29 year old Milwaukee man was arrested on a valid South Milwaukee Police Department warrant following a traffic stop in the 1100 Block of Columbia Avenue at 6:35 pm on September 8<sup>th</sup>. The man was given a court date and released after signing a personal recognizance bond.

A 28 year old South Milwaukee woman was arrested on valid warrants with the New Berlin Police Department in the 1200 Block of Drexel Blvd. just before 11:30 am on September 6<sup>th</sup> after an officer noticed her vehicle swerving and conducted a traffic stop. The woman showed no signs of impairment. She was taken to the police department where she posted bond on the warrants.

## **PARK VIOLATION**

A 22 year old South Milwaukee man and an 18 year old Cudahy woman were issued citations for being in Grant Park after hours when officers located them in a parked vehicle at 3:39 am on September 5<sup>th</sup> in Areas 7,8, and 9 of Grant Park.
