

# **SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

## **WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 10/01/18 – 10/07/18**



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **280** calls for service.

### **BURGLARY**

Tools and other items were reported missing after a garage in the 1700 Block of Blake Avenue was entered sometime between Midnight and 7:00 am on October 2<sup>nd</sup>. Officers processed the scene for evidence and an investigation is ongoing.

### **HIT AND RUN ACCIDENT**

A van parked in the 1900 Block of 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue was struck and pushed onto the curb at 9:10 pm on October 4<sup>th</sup>. Officers located the striking vehicle a short time later travelling with damage in the city of Cudahy and a traffic stop was initiated. The driver, a 29 year old South Milwaukee woman was issued citations for Hit and Run and Failure to Keep her Vehicle Under Control.

### **CRIMINAL DAMAGE**

A resident reported the tires were slashed on his vehicle while it was parked on Minnesota Avenue near 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue between 5:30 pm on October 2<sup>nd</sup> and 6:00 am on October 3<sup>rd</sup>. The vehicle was also sustained exterior damage that appeared to be caused by a key.

## **ARREST WARRANT**

**A 23 year old South Milwaukee man was arrested on a confirmed warrant with Probation and Parole after officers were dispatched to a report of people arguing in the 300 Block of Southtowne Drive at 3:38 pm on October 5th. The man was also found to be in possession of drug paraphernalia and he was issued a citation before being taken to the Milwaukee County Jail on the warrant.**

**A 33 year old South Milwaukee woman was arrested on a confirmed traffic warrant with the Oak Creek Police Department at 10:10 pm on October 1<sup>st</sup> in the 600 Block of Montana Avenue following a traffic stop. After being taken to the police station, the woman was released on a Personal Recognizance Bond.**
