

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 10/15/18 – 10/21/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **261** calls for service.

LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSIST

South Milwaukee Police Department officers assisted Oak Creek Police Department officers on a high-risk traffic stop on a reported stolen vehicle in the 1800 Block of Drexel Blvd. just before midnight on October 15th. The vehicle was stopped without incident and three individuals were taken into custody by the Oak Creek Police Department.

BATTERY

A 43 year old South Milwaukee man was charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with Physical Abuse of a Child and Bail Jumping after striking a 17 year old South Milwaukee boy at 10:00 pm on October 18th in the 900 Block of Monroe Avenue.

TRESPASS

A 28 year old Milwaukee woman was issued a citation for Trespassing at Wal Mart at 11:32 am on October 14th. The woman, who was prohibited from entering any Wal Mart store due to a previous retail theft incident in West Milwaukee, was in the South Milwaukee store attempting to return merchandise.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

A 31 year old Oak Creek woman was issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated and Operating Left of Center at 2:20 am on October 18th following a traffic stop in the 1700 Block of Drexel Blvd. An officer observed the woman's vehicle swerve across the center line on Nicholson Avenue just prior to the traffic stop. The woman was issued citations and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office before being released to a sober responsible adult.

A 38 year old Oak Creek man was issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated and Unnecessary Acceleration following a traffic stop in the 2600 Block of 5th Avenue at 2:29 am on October 21st. The man was issued citations and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Operating While Intoxicated-2nd Offense.

WARRANT ARREST

A 35 year old Racine woman was arrested on a confirmed warrant with the Racine County Sheriff's Office following a traffic stop where an officer stopped a vehicle operating without headlights in the 2500 Block of South Chicago Avenue at 3:26 am on October 21st. The woman was taken to the police station where bail was posted on the warrant and she was released.
