## ***WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 10/22/18 – 10/28/18***

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **399** calls for service.

### **LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSIST**

South Milwaukee Police Department officers were requested to assist in locating a suspect who had fled from Cudahy Police Department officers at 11:19 am on October 27<sup>th</sup>. The suspect, who had been involved in crashes on I-794, crashed his vehicle in a Cudahy condo complex near 15<sup>th</sup> and College Avenues and had fled the area on foot. The suspect, a 56 year old Cudahy man, was apprehended without incident and taken into custody by officers from the Cudahy Police Department.

### **BATTERY**

A 24 year old South Milwaukee man reported being struck by a known individual in the 2300 Block of 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue at 2:12 am on October 23<sup>rd</sup>. A 25 year old Cudahy man was issued a citation for Battery.

## **DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

An officer observed a 38 year old West Allis man appearing to be pan handling in the roadway at College and North Chicago Avenues at 9:35 pm on October 22<sup>nd</sup>. After being warned on pan handling and advised to stay out of the road, the man began to yell and make obscene gestures at passing cars. A 37 year old Milwaukee man who was with the West Allis man also began to shout profanities. Both were arrested and taken to the police station. Both men were issued citations for Disorderly Conduct. The West Allis man was also issued citations for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Criminal Damage to Property after having a pipe with marijuana residue on it and causing damage in the jail cell.

## **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

A 57 year old South Milwaukee man was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Operating While Intoxicated-3<sup>rd</sup> Offense and Recklessly Endangering Safety after officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle striking a house in the 1400 Block of Willow Lane just after 3:30 pm on October 27<sup>th</sup>.

A 64 year old St. Francis man was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Operating While Intoxicated-5<sup>th</sup> Offense after a citizen reported a vehicle swerving and driving slow near 5<sup>th</sup> and Forest Hill Avenues at 11:16 pm on October 26<sup>th</sup>. Officers located the vehicle and observed it swerving before conducting a traffic stop. The driver was arrested and taken to the police station. He was also issued citations for Operating After Suspension and Operating Left of Center
