

# ***SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT***

## ***WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 10/08/18 – 10/14/18***



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **293** calls for service.

### **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE**

Officers were dispatched to a Domestic Violence incident in the 3300 Block of Marina Road at 1:40 pm on October 9<sup>th</sup> which resulted in the arrest of a 55 year old South Milwaukee man who argued with his wife and son. The man was taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility after which the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office issued charges of Domestic Violence Battery, Recklessly Endangering Safety, and Disorderly Conduct, among other charges.

### **DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

Officers were dispatched to a report of an argument between a 70 year old South Milwaukee man and a 47 year old South Milwaukee woman in the 1300 Block of Rawson Avenue just after 11:00 am on October 8<sup>th</sup>. The woman was also found to have a confirmed warrant with Probation and Parole. She was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on Disorderly Conduct charges and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility on the Probation and Parole warrant.

## **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

A 48 year old South Milwaukee man was issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated following a traffic stop near 15<sup>th</sup> and Rawson Avenues at 7:19 pm on October 13<sup>th</sup>. Another motorist had called the police department to report the man's vehicle driving erratically for several blocks prior to the stop. The man was arrested and taken to the police station where he was issued the citations.

## **CRIMINAL DAMAGE**

A resident in the 1600 Block of Menomonee Avenue reported damage to his vehicle that appeared to be caused by a key on October 11<sup>th</sup>. The damage occurred sometime between 8:00 am on September 25<sup>th</sup> and 7:30 am on September 27<sup>th</sup>.

Windows were reported broken and graffiti was observed on buildings in the 2200 Block of 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue just after Noon on October 10<sup>th</sup>. An investigation is on-going.

## **THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE**

Multiple items were reported taken from vehicles in the 1600 and 1700 Blocks of Lakeview Avenue and the 200 and 300 Blocks of Hemlock Court during the overnight hours of October 10<sup>th</sup>. One of the victims on Lakeview Avenue observed four younger individuals entering her vehicle and they fled the area in a light colored SUV when confronted by the victim. Later that day the Oak Creek Police Department recovered a stolen vehicle in a hotel parking lot that matched the description of the suspect vehicle. Officers located some of the items taken in the South Milwaukee thefts inside that vehicle that was reported stolen out of Wauwatosa. Based on evidence collected, suspects in this case are in the process of being identified and an investigation is on-going.
