

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 09/10/18 – 09/17/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **303** calls for service.

WARRANT ARREST

A 21 year old South Milwaukee man was arrested on a valid warrant with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department after officers were dispatched to a report of a group of individuals about to fight at 12th and Milwaukee Avenues at 12:40 pm on September 15th. Officers encountered four individuals arguing but no actual fight took place. The 21 year old man was arrested on the valid warrant and turned over to Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department deputies.

A 21 year old South Milwaukee man was arrested on three valid South Milwaukee Police Department warrants after being involved in a motor vehicle accident at 5th and Madison Avenues just before 5:30 pm on September 11th. The man was taken to the police station where money was posted on one of the warrants and he was released on a Personal Recognizance bond with a court date on the other two.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

A 32 year old South Milwaukee woman was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Operating While Intoxicated-2nd Offense, Operating Left of Center, and Operating After Revocation. She was also issued a Municipal citation for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia following a traffic stop in the 2000 Block of 10th Avenue at 1:49 am on September 16th. The woman was taken to the police station where she was booked prior to being taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility.

A 47 year old South Milwaukee man was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Operating While Intoxicated-2nd Offense, Prohibited Alcohol Concentration, and Operating After Revocation after he collided with a parked vehicle in the 1700 Block of Milwaukee Avenue at 1:48 am on September 15th. The man was also issued a Municipal citation for Failure to Keep his Vehicle Under Control. The man was taken to the police station and booked before being taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility.

An officer operating an unmarked squad noticed a vehicle following close behind him with the driver motioning to drive faster in the 2400 Block of Nicholson Avenue at 6:49 pm on September 12th. The officer allowed the vehicle to pass and conducted a traffic stop. The driver, a 70 year old Pembine man, was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated.
