

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 09/18/18 – 09/23/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **233** calls for service.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

A 30 year old South Milwaukee man was issued citations for Disorderly Conduct and Resisting Arrest at 3:23 pm on September 23rd after officers were dispatched to a report of an individual refusing to leave a residence in the 400 Block of 11th Avenue. Upon arrival the man argued with officers and refused to leave the property. He was arrested and taken to the police station where he was issued citations before being released.

UNLAWFUL BURNING

An officer noticed a large amount of smoke in the 1500 Block of Michigan Avenue at 1:44 am on September 23rd and located an unattended bonfire behind a residence in the area. The fire was extinguished by South Milwaukee Fire Department personnel and officers received no answer at the residence. The listed property owner was issued citations for Unlawful Burning and Negligent Handling of Burning Materials.

WARRANT ARREST

A 32 year old Milwaukee woman was arrested on a valid warrant with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue at 5:25 pm on September 18th following a tip from a citizen. The woman was taken to the police station where she was turned over to Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department deputies.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

A citizen reported observing several long scratches to his vehicle while it was parked in a lot in the 2900 Block of Chicago Avenue at 12:54 pm on September 21st. The citizen also reported having exchanged words with another individual upon arriving in the lot regarding a barking dog in that individual's car. Upon returning, the citizen noticed the scratches and the other individual and vehicle were gone. No description of the other individual or vehicle were given and an investigation is ongoing.

RETAIL THEFT

A 38 year old Milwaukee man was issued a citation for Retail Theft at WalMart in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue at 3:41 pm after store security personnel observed him open a box of over-the-counter medication and place the bottle in his pocket. When he left the store without paying for the medication he was detained and police were called. The man was taken to the police station where he was issued a citation for Retail Theft and released.
