

# **SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

## **WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 09/24/18 – 09/30/18**



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **226** calls for service.

### **DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

A 31 year old South Milwaukee man was arrested on a valid Probation and Parole violation at 2:29 am on September 29<sup>th</sup> after officers were dispatched to a report of a subject arguing with people in the 1100 Block of Milwaukee Avenue. The individuals involved in the argument left the area without incident while the 31 year old man was taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility on the Probation violation.

### **HIT AND RUN ACCIDENT**

An officer noticed a Toyota Corolla parked with damage in the 900 Block of Monroe Avenue around 9:00 am on September 29<sup>th</sup>. A Toyota RAV 4 was also located parked with damage across the street. Witnesses told officers the RAV 4 struck the Corolla earlier that morning between 2-4 am. Witnesses also identified the owner of the RAV 4, a 24 year old Milwaukee woman, as the striking driver and she was issued citations for Hit and Run Unattended Vehicle, Failure to Keep Vehicle Under Control, Owner's Liability Failure to Notify of an Accident, and Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Insurance.

**A resident in the 300 Block of Southtowne Drive reported his vehicle was struck and the side mirror damaged by an unknown vehicle sometime between 4:00 pm on September 28<sup>th</sup> and 10:30 am on September 30<sup>th</sup>.**

### **SUSPICIOUS VEHICLE**

**Officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle parked in the 300 Block of Edgewood Avenue with smoke coming out of the driver's side front window at 7:40 pm on September 25<sup>th</sup>. Officers located the vehicle parked in the area and occupied by five individuals. The driver, an 18 year old South Milwaukee man, admitted to smoking Marijuana and had a glass pipe in the vehicle. He was arrested and taken to the police station where he was issued a citation for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and released.**

### **THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE**

**Officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle parked with its trunk open and a bowling ball and bag in the middle of the roadway in the 1700 Block of Beech Street around 9:00 pm on September 28<sup>th</sup>. Officers contacted the vehicle owner who stated the bowling ball and bag were his but a Green Bay Packer bowling ball bag, two bowling balls, and a pair of bowling shoes were missing. Those items were soon located in the 1800 Block of Beech Street and were returned to the owner.**
