

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 10/29/18 – 11/04/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **308** calls for service.

HIT AND RUN ACCIDENT

A 19 year old Milwaukee man reported his vehicle was struck while driving in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue at 4:45 pm on November 4th by a vehicle driven by an 18 year old Milwaukee woman who was known to him. The Milwaukee woman left the scene prior to the arrival of officers. Later in the evening the same individuals were involved in another situation in the city of Milwaukee requiring the response of the Milwaukee Police Department. A Milwaukee police officer contacted the South Milwaukee officer investigating the earlier accident and a citation for Hit and Run will be issued to the Milwaukee woman.

A 20 year old South Milwaukee woman reported her vehicle was struck while parked in the 700 Block of Sherman Avenue sometime between 10:00 am and 12:50 pm on November 4th. Based upon pieces and parts located on the scene, the striking vehicle appears to be green in color and an investigation is ongoing.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

A 42 year old South Milwaukee man was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct after officers were dispatched to a report of individuals involved in an altercation in the 1300 Block of Milwaukee Avenue at 2:42 pm on October 30th.

A 62 year old South Milwaukee woman was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct after officers were dispatched to a report of subjects arguing in the 600 Block of Columbia Avenue at 10:19 am on October 29th. Upon investigation, the woman was determined to be the primary aggressor in the argument and the citation was issued.

A 46 year old Milwaukee woman was issued citations for Resisting Arrest and Obstructing an Officer after officers were dispatched to a report of an argument in the 2700 Block of 5th Avenue at 9:34 pm on November 1st. The woman gave false identification information to the officer and continued to be disorderly before being arrested. She was taken to the police station where she continued to be uncooperative. Following fingerprint identification it was discovered there was a warrant for her arrest with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department. After receiving her citations, the woman was turned over to Milwaukee County Sheriff's deputies on their warrant.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

Officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle parked in the 800 Block of Marshall Avenue with the occupants engaged in illegal drug activity at 10:45 am on November 2nd. Upon the officer's arrival, the vehicle left the scene and it was later located in the 900 Block of Monroe Avenue. A 26-year old South Milwaukee woman was issued citations for Operating Under the Influence (Controlled Substance) and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

At 5:42 pm on November 3rd, officers were dispatched to a parking lot in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue for a report of a possible intoxicated driver. A caller reported a vehicle bumped into another vehicle in the lot and the driver appeared to be impaired. Officers located the vehicle and the driver, a 62 year old Oak Creek man, and began an investigation. The man was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Operating While Intoxicated-6th Offense.
