

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 11/12/18 – 11/25/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **431** calls for service.

FOLLOW UP-ARMED ROBBERY

Two 18 year old Milwaukee men and a 17 year old Milwaukee boy were arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office in connection with a November 10th armed robbery in the 2300 Block of 10th Avenue.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

A 22 year old Milwaukee man was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Disorderly Conduct after officers were dispatched to a report of an intoxicated subject damaging items inside an apartment in the 500 Block of Southtowne Place just after 8:30 pm on November 23rd.

A 53 year old man was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct after he swore at employees and began to undress in the lobby of a business in the 1000 Block of Milwaukee Avenue at 1:04 pm on November 12th. The man, who was intoxicated, was also advised he would be cited for Trespassing if he returned to the business.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

A 52 year old South Milwaukee man was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Operating While Intoxicated-3rd Offense following a traffic stop in the 1100 Block of Milwaukee Avenue at 2:34 am on November 24th. An officer observed the man's vehicle fail to stop at a stop sign at 9th and Milwaukee Avenues and conducted the traffic stop.

A citizen reported a vehicle left the roadway and nearly struck a tree at 9th and Montana Avenues before leaving the scene at 11:37 pm on November 23rd. Based on information provided by the caller, officers located the vehicle parked with a flat tire and mud stuck under it at a residence in the 500 Block of Mackinac Avenue. A 41 year old female admitted to driving the vehicle and was subsequently arrested and issued a citation for Operating While Intoxicated-1st Offense.

An officer stopped a vehicle with a headlight out near Nicholson and Rawson Avenues at 11:01 pm on November 23rd. The driver, a 17 year old Oak Creek boy, appeared impaired and admitted recent marijuana use. A pipe with marijuana was also located in the vehicle. The driver was arrested and issued citations for Operating Under the Influence and Possession of Marijuana before being turned over to his parents.

An officer on patrol noticed a subject standing near a vehicle parked against traffic with minor front end damage and tracks leading toward a utility pole guide wire near 15th Avenue and Maple Street at 5:31 pm on November 21st. The driver, a 32 year old Cudahy man, appeared impaired and stated he recently used prescription medication. Upon searching the man, heroin, prescription medication, and syringes were also located. He was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Operating Under the Influence-3rd Offense and Possession of Heroin.
