

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 11/04/18 – 11/11/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

Last week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **250** calls for service.

ARMED ROBBERY

A citizen reported being robbed at gunpoint in the 2300 Block of 10th Avenue just before 5:00 pm on November 10th. Information was later obtained that differed from the original report and an investigation is ongoing.

RETAIL THEFT

A male subject wearing an olive green winter jacket and a Green Bay Packers sweatshirt and winter hat left the Pick and Save store in the 2900 Block of South Chicago without paying for three bags of chips and a bottle of vodka at 1:17 pm on November 7th. The man fled the area when confronted by store employees and an investigation is ongoing.

A male subject wearing a blue jacket with a yellow stripe and a dark knit cap left Ace Hardware in the 1000 Block of Marquette Avenue without paying for a Milwaukee Tool drill kit. A store employee ran after the man and attempted to stop him but was unsuccessful. The surrounding area was checked but the suspect was not located and an investigation is ongoing.

WARRANT ARREST

A 20 year old South Milwaukee man came to the police department at 11:55 am on November 9th to turn himself in on a confirmed warrant with the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department. The man was taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility to be turned over to Waukesha County Sheriff's Department authorities.

FRAUD

Officers were dispatched to a report of subjects not paying a taxi cab fare in the 3300 Block of Marina Road at 4:46 pm on November 4th. A 31 year old Milwaukee woman and taken a taxi ride from Milwaukee to meet a 33 year old South Milwaukee man. Upon arrival neither were able to pay the fare and the woman was issued a citation for theft.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

A 29 year old South Milwaukee man was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office and charged with Disorderly Conduct after being involved in an altercation with a 29 year old South Milwaukee woman in the 1400 Block of Minnesota Avenue at 10:37 pm on November 10th.
