

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 11/26/18 – 12/02/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **226** calls for service.

ARMED ROBBERY

On November 27th, at approximately 11:00 AM, a robbery occurred at the Associated Bank branch in South Milwaukee (2815 S. Chicago Avenue). A male suspect implied a weapon and obtained an undetermined amount of money before fleeing on foot. The suspect is described as a thin black male, 20's to early 30's, wearing a dark colored hooded jacket or sweatshirt, dark jeans, and white and black athletic shoes. WARRANT ARREST

A 21 year old South Milwaukee man was arrested on a confirmed warrant with Probation and Parole and a 21 year old Oak Creek man was issued a citation for Possession of Marijuana after officers were dispatched to a suspicious occupied vehicle in the 2700 Block of South Chicago Avenue at 5:34 pm on December 2nd. Both men were taken to the Police Station where the Oak Creek man was issued the citation and released while the South Milwaukee man was taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility on the confirmed warrant.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

A 68 year old South Milwaukee man was issued a citation for Operating While Intoxicated-First Offense after officers were dispatched to a minor vehicle crash in the 2300 Block of 12th Avenue at 5:53 pm on November 30th. The South Milwaukee man, who showed signs of impairment while speaking with officers, stated he backed into the other vehicle. He was subsequently arrested and taken to the police station where he was cited for Operating While Intoxicated.

HIT AND RUN ACCIDENT

Officers were dispatched to a report of a dark colored vehicle leaving the roadway in the 1200 Block of 15th Avenue and striking a sign and a tree before continuing southbound at 3:04 pm on November 26th. A short while later, an officer stopped a vehicle matching the description with front end damage just into the city of Cudahy. The driver, a 90 year old Cudahy woman, admitted to being in the accident and was issued citations for Hit and Run and Reckless Driving.

RETAIL THEFT

Officers were dispatched to a report of a subject leaving Pic N Save in the 2900 Block of South Chicago without paying for a bag of salad at 8:16 am on November 29th. Employees observed the subject enter a Milwaukee County Transit Bus. Officers stopped the bus a few blocks away and located the subject, a 41 year old Milwaukee woman along with the salad bag. She was arrested and cited for Retail Theft.
