

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 12/17/18 – 12/25/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **295** calls for service.

ARREST-ARMED ROBBERY

Through a collaborative effort with officers from the St. Francis and Milwaukee Police Departments, a suspect in the November 27th armed robbery at the South Milwaukee Associated Bank was identified and located. A 32 year old Milwaukee man was arrested and charged with Robbery of a Financial Institution in the South Milwaukee robbery as well as one in St. Francis. He was also charged with Attempted Robbery of a bank in Milwaukee.

GARAGE FIRE

Officers and Fire Department personnel were dispatched to a garage fire in the 600 Block of Elm Avenue around 4:00 am on December 24th. There were no injuries and the fire was extinguished however significant damage occurred to the garage and property inside. The South Milwaukee Police Department and Fire Department continue to investigate the incident as it appears to have originated under suspicious circumstances.

RESTRAINING ORDER VIOLATION

A 62 year old South Milwaukee woman was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for possible charges of Violating a Restraining Order after she reportedly shouted at and made an obscene gesture towards a 21 year old South Milwaukee woman in the 600 Block of Columbia Avenue at 4:08 pm on December 20th.

WARRANT ARREST

A 25 year old Milwaukee woman was arrested on a confirmed warrant with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office after officers were dispatched to a report of a unwanted person knocking on the door of an apartment in the 3300 Block of 5th Avenue at 12:52 am on December 21st. The woman was taken to the Police Department where she was later turned over to deputies from the Milwaukee County Sherriff's Office on the warrant.

VEHICLE THEFT

A resident in the 600 Block of Mackinac Avenue reported his vehicle and ignition key taken from his residence sometime between December 22nd and December 24th. Later that evening the vehicle was located by Milwaukee County Sheriff's Deputies unoccupied and involved in an accident near Marquette University.

A resident in the 1400 Block of Marshall Avenue reported the theft of a package off his porch sometime between 11:00 am and 3:00 pm on December 24th. The resident was sent notification the package was delivered but it was not there when he returned home.
