

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 12/3/18 – 12/16/18



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **485** calls for service.

DRUG INVESTIGATION

Officers were dispatched to a report of an unresponsive person in the 300 Block of Marquette Avenue at 7:34 pm on December 5th. Upon arrival a 61 year old female was found deceased from an apparent drug overdose. Through their investigation, officers were able to identify and locate a 34 year old Milwaukee man as the supplier of the drugs and he was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility to await charges.

WEAPONS VIOLATION

A 24 year old South Milwaukee man was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Endangering Safety By Use of a Dangerous Weapon while Intoxicated after officers were dispatched to a report of a subject yelling and walking with a gun in the 2300 Blk of 12th Avenue at 12:30 am on December 16th. The South Milwaukee man was located in a nearby alley with a rifle and showed signs of impairment. He was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

A 21 year old Cudahy woman was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct after officers were dispatched to a report of an individual arguing with employees at a restaurant in the 100 Block of N Chicago Avenue at 10:53 am on December 9th. The investigation revealed the Cudahy woman entered the restaurant after a confrontation with an employee and threw a soda.

Officers were dispatched to a report of a fight between two females at a tavern in the 1800 Block of 10th Avenue at 1:35 am on December 6th. The investigation revealed a 33 year old Milwaukee woman was involved in an altercation with an unknown female who left the tavern prior to the arrival of officers. The Milwaukee woman was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct and once identified, the female who left will be issued a Disorderly Conduct citation as well.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

A 19 year old Cudahy man was issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated-1st Offense after officers were dispatched to report of a pick-up truck stuck on the railroad tracks in the 1100 Block of Park Avenue at 11:12 pm on December 9th.

A 22 year old Oak Creek man was issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated-1st Offense after officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle striking a pole in the 1100 Block of Milwaukee Avenue at 3:39 am on December 16th.
